The Boy in the Striped Pajamas Vocabulary Activities Quality is a keyword in animal production. Next to product quality, process quality has also become relevant for dairy farmers. Issues like food safety, public health, animal health and welfare are determined by the conditions of the production process. To address these, the EU has issued the General Food Law (178-2002) and the Hygiene directives (EC 853/854/855-2004) dealing with the forenamed with the aim to protect consumers. The suggestion was also made by the EU that farmers apply a HACCP-like process to meet these new quality demands. Key issues are structure, organisation, planning, formalisation and demonstration which can also be found in the HACCP concept. This book addresses Quality Risk Management through applying a HACCP-like concept. Breaking the myth of Harrison as a one-hit wonder, Kirchhelle reconstructs Harrison's 46 years of campaigning and the rapid transformation of welfare politics and science during this time. Exacerbated by Harrison's own actions, the decades after 1964 saw a polarisation of animal politics, a professionalisation of British activism, and the rise of a new animal welfare science. Harrison's belief in incremental reform allowed her to form ties to leading scientists but alienated her from more radical campaigners. Many of the 1964 demands gradually became part of mainstream politics. However, farm animal welfare's increasing marketisation has also led to a relative divorce from the wider agenda of social improvement that Harrison once witnessed. This is the first book to cast light on the interlinked histories of British farm animal welfare activism, science, and legislation. Its unique scope allows it to go beyond existing accounts of modern British animal welfare.
